

CRONO WEB APPLICATION

Regulations for access and use of the infusion pump monitoring platform

Introduction

The **CRONO**[®] infusion pump monitoring platform is a tool designed exclusively for authorised healthcare professionals, in order to ensure effective and secure monitoring of patients' clinical data. Access to and use of the platform must comply with current legislation on data protection and information security.

Rules for Access and Use

1. Confidentiality of Credentials

- Each user may access the platform using personal and non-transferable credentials.
- It is strictly prohibited to share usernames and passwords with others, including colleagues.
- Passwords must meet the complexity requirements defined by the system.

2. Protection of Information

- All data displayed and processed on the platform are strictly confidential and must be used solely for clinical purposes.
- It is prohibited to save, print, or distribute such data without explicit authorisation.
- In the event of a suspected unauthorised access, the user must immediately inform the Security Officer.

3. Secure Access

- Access to the platform must be made from secure devices protected by up-to-date antivirus software.
- Users are required to log out from the platform at the end of each working session.
- It is not permitted to access the platform using public or unsecured Wi-Fi networks.

4. User Responsibility

- The user is responsible for all activities performed using their credentials.
- Any misuse or breach of these rules will result in disciplinary measures and, if necessary, legal action.

5. Declaration of Responsibility

- The user declares that they have received adequate training on the use of the software and on IT security rules.
- The user undertakes to download and install any software updates when available.

Final Provisions

This regulation must be signed by each user before being granted access to the platform. Failure to comply with these rules will result in the immediate revocation of access and may lead to further disciplinary or legal measures.
